## EasyLine Management Recommendations

### Day 1- At Placement

Adjust standpipe pressure to 18" – 20"

Place starter balls in cups prior to placing poult

Adjust the height of drinker line so that the bottoms of the cups are just above the litter

Take care to see the cups are low enough for poult to easily see and find the water

### Day 3-5

Remove the starter balls from the cups

Raise water line height approximately 1"

### Day 5-7

Decrease standpipe pressure to approximately 8" – 10"

Raise the water line height where poult are just able to reach over the edge of the cup into the bottom to drink easily.

### From Day 8 onward

Continue to raise water line at least every two days; keeping the line low enough that all birds can reach into the bottom of the cup but high enough that the edges of the cup are kept clean by the birds feathers, "wiping" it off.

### At weeks 5-6

Increase standpipe pressure as necessary dependant upon age, density, and temperature. **Note: the tendency is to run more pressure than necessary, resulting in excessive water in the cups and spillage onto the litter.**
